ORDINANCE NO. 837

AN ORDINANCE, vacating a portion of 163rd Avenue N.E., in the Plat of Pacific Plan, Inc., within the City of Redmond, King County, Washington.

WHEREAS, a written Petition for the Vacation of Street, No. RV-78-3, signed by in excess of two-thirds of the property owners abutting thereon, was filed with the City Clerk and presented to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council by Resolution No. 465 set the date of July 18, 1978, at 8:00 P.M., at the City Hall, before the City Council, as the time, place and authority for a public hearing to be held on said Petition; and

WHEREAS, due and proper notice of such hearing has been made in accordance with law; and

WHEREAS, the hearing having been duly held, there being no objections by any of the abutting property owners, and the City Council having determined that it is in the best interest of the City and the property owners concerned that such street and public way be vacated, Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Street vacation granted. That the Petition be granted, and the street and public way depicted on the sketch or map on the attached Exhibit "A" and described as follows is hereby declared vacated:

The north 140 feet of 163rd Avenue N.E., as platted in the plat of Pacific Plan, Inc., Addition No. 1, and attached turning easements on lots 6 and 7, recorded in Volume 62 of Plats, page 100, Records of King County, Washington.


Situate in the City of Redmond, King County, Washington.

with each half of the vacated street and public way property vesting in the abutting property owners of Lots 5, 6, 7 and 8, Pacific Plan, Inc., and respectively becoming a part of said lots as provided by law.

Section 2. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 13<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1978.



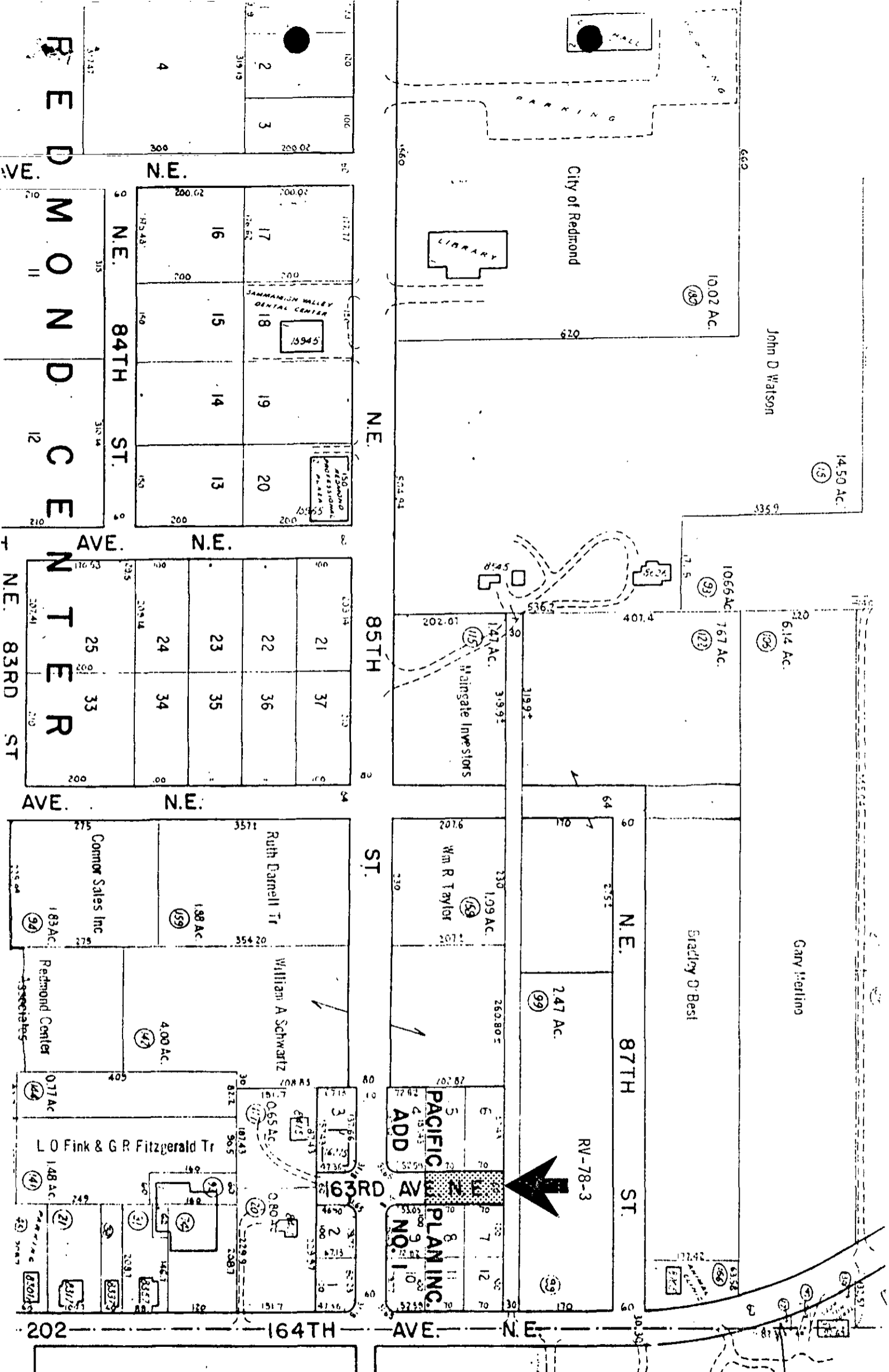
