ORDINANCE NO. 839

AN ORDINANCE, relating to fire protection and prevention and repealing Ordinance 144, passed May 2, 1951.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 144, passed May 2, 1951, established a permit system and regulations relating to outdoor fires which is now governed and regulated by the Uniform Fire Code adopted by ordinance and codified as Chapter 15.28, Fire Code, of the Redmond Municipal Code, so that Ordinance 144 should be repealed, Now, Therefore,


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Repeal. Ordinance No. 144, passed May 2, 1951, and Chapter 9.28 of the Redmond Municipal Code are each hereby repealed.

Section 2. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.


