An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No.32 And Repealing Ordinance No.62. Governing The Conduct Of Pool Rooms, Billiard Rooms, Bowling Alleys And Card Rooms Within The Town Of Redmond, And Providing For The License Thereof.

Be It Ordained By The Town Council Of The Town Of Redmond,
As Follows;

That section No.1 of Ordinance No.32 be amended to read as follows; It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to open, carry on, maintain or conduct any Billiard room, Pool room, Bowling alley, Card room or Room for the playing of any other game within the Town of Redmond, without first taking out and procuring a license so to do. Such license to be known as a Billiard and Card table license. The fee for any such Billiard and Card table license shall be the sum of \$120.00 Dollars per year payable quarterly in advance. Ordinance No.62 is hereby repealed.
