ORDINANCE NO. 848

AN ORDINANCE, relating to the 1979 tax levy and amending Section 1 of Ordinance No. 842.

Section 1. Amendment. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 842, passed September 19, 1978, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. Taxes levied for 1978. There is hereby levied upon all taxable property, both real and personal, within the City of Redmond, King County, Washington, for general taxation purposes and voted excess levies for general obligation bond issues, an ad valorem tax levy upon the assessed valuation of such taxable property for the year 1979, as follows:

General Tax Levy	\$3.60 per \$1,000 Assessment Value
Excess Tax Levy	\$302,450.00


and the City does hereby certify that the estimated amount necessary to be raised by the general tax levy is the sum of \$1,088,252.36, exclusive of any supplemental collections of prior year's taxes due as a result of the Burlington Northern case.

Provided, that the application of the general tax levy shall be consistent with and not result in an increase in tax revenues in excess of the limitations imposed by law.

Section 2. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 21<sup>ST</sup> day of November, 1978.
