

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 866

AN ORDINANCE, relating to finances; adopting a Supplemental Budget for 1979, for the Current Expense Fund (001) and Right-of-Way Acquisition Fund (314), to appropriate and provide for expenditures from unanticipated revenues, cash balances, grant receipts and fund transfers; and reappropriating expenditures from the Revenue Sharing Fund (199).

WHEREAS, the City anticipates receiving \$203,000 in revenues to the City which were not anticipated at the time the 1979 budget was adopted by Ordinance No. 850; and it is necessary that these funds be appropriated for the year 1979 as a supplement to the 1979 budget; Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Supplemental Budget adopted. There is hereby adopted a Supplemental Budget for the City of Redmond for the Current Expense Fund (001) and Right-of-Way Acquisition Fund (314), and there is hereby appropriated from unanticipated revenues received by the City cash balances, grant receipts, fund transfers, and other unappropriated revenues, the following expenditures for the budget year 1979, as a supplement to the 1979 budget adopted by Ordinance No. 850:



Section 2. Reappropriation. The expenditure of funds in the Revenue Sharing Fund (199) in the amount of \$49,500, is hereby reappropriated from land acquisition to street sweeper.

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its publication in the manner provided by law.
