

An ordinance of the Town of Redmond, licensing Dance halls, fixing the license fee, excluding certain minors therefrom and fixing the time of closing.

Sec. 1 It shall be unlawful for any person, organization, firm or corporation to operate a dance hall in the Town of Redmond without first having secured a license so to do. The fee for such license shall be One Dollar (\$1.00) for each time that a dance is held.

Such license shall be issued by the Town Clerk upon receipt of One Dollar. No dance shall continue later than One o'clock A.M.

Sec. 2 All minors under the age of sixteen years shall not be allowed in dance halls, unless accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. Any person, firm, organization or corporation operating a dance for any public benefit shall receive a dance license free of charge by applying to the Town Clerk for same.

Sec. 3 Each and every dance operated in the Town of Redmond shall be policed to the satisfaction of the Town authorities, without cost to the Town, by the party or parties operating such dance.

Penalty

Anyone failing to comply with the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not more than \$25.00 or be imprisoned in the Town or County Jail for not more than 10 days, or both such fine and imprisonment may be imposed.
