ORDINANCE NO. 874

AN ORDINANCE, relating to animal control;
and amending Section 7.04.460 of the
Redmond Municipal Code.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Amendment. Section 7.04.460 of the Redmond Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"7.04.460 Civil penalty. In addition to any other penalty provided herein or by law, any person whose animal is in violation of this chapter shall incur a civil penalty plus actual costs incurred by the animal control authority. The civil penalty for the first notice of violation shall be twenty-five dollars; fifty dollars for the second notice of violation; and one hundred dollars for each successive violation. The court shall impose the civil penalty upon finding a violation has been committed, no part of which shall be reduced or suspended. Failure to pay such penalty shall constitute a separate offense under this chapter and shall subject the animal to impoundment as herein provided."

Section 2. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.
