

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 881

AN ORDINANCE, vacating an alley in Sikes
3rd Addition within the City of Redmond,
King County, Washington.

WHEREAS, a written Petition for the Vacation of Street
No. RV-79-5, signed by in excess of two-thirds of the property
owners abutting thereon, was filed with the City Clerk and pre-
sented to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council by Resolution No. 501, set the
date of July 17, 1979, at 8:00 P.M., at the City Hall, before
the City Council, as the time, place and authority for a public
hearing to be held on said petition; and

WHEREAS, due and proper notice of such hearing has been
made in accordance with law; and

WHEREAS, the hearing having been duly held, there being
no objections by any of the abutting property owners, and the
City Council having determined that it is in the best interest
of the City and the property owners concerned that such street
and public way be vacated, Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Street vacation granted. That the Petition be granted,
and the street and public way depicted on the sketch or map on
the attached Exhibit "A" and described as follows is hereby
declared vacated:

A 16 foot wide alley platted in block 1 Sikes
3rd Addition to the City of Redmond, according to
plat recorded in Volume 9 of plats, page 68, in
King County, Washington.

Situate in the City of Redmond, King County, Washington.

With title to one-half of the vacated street and public way each
vesting in the abutting property owners as provided by law.

Section 2. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect
and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication
in the manner provided by law.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington,
at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor
this 7TH day of August, 1979.

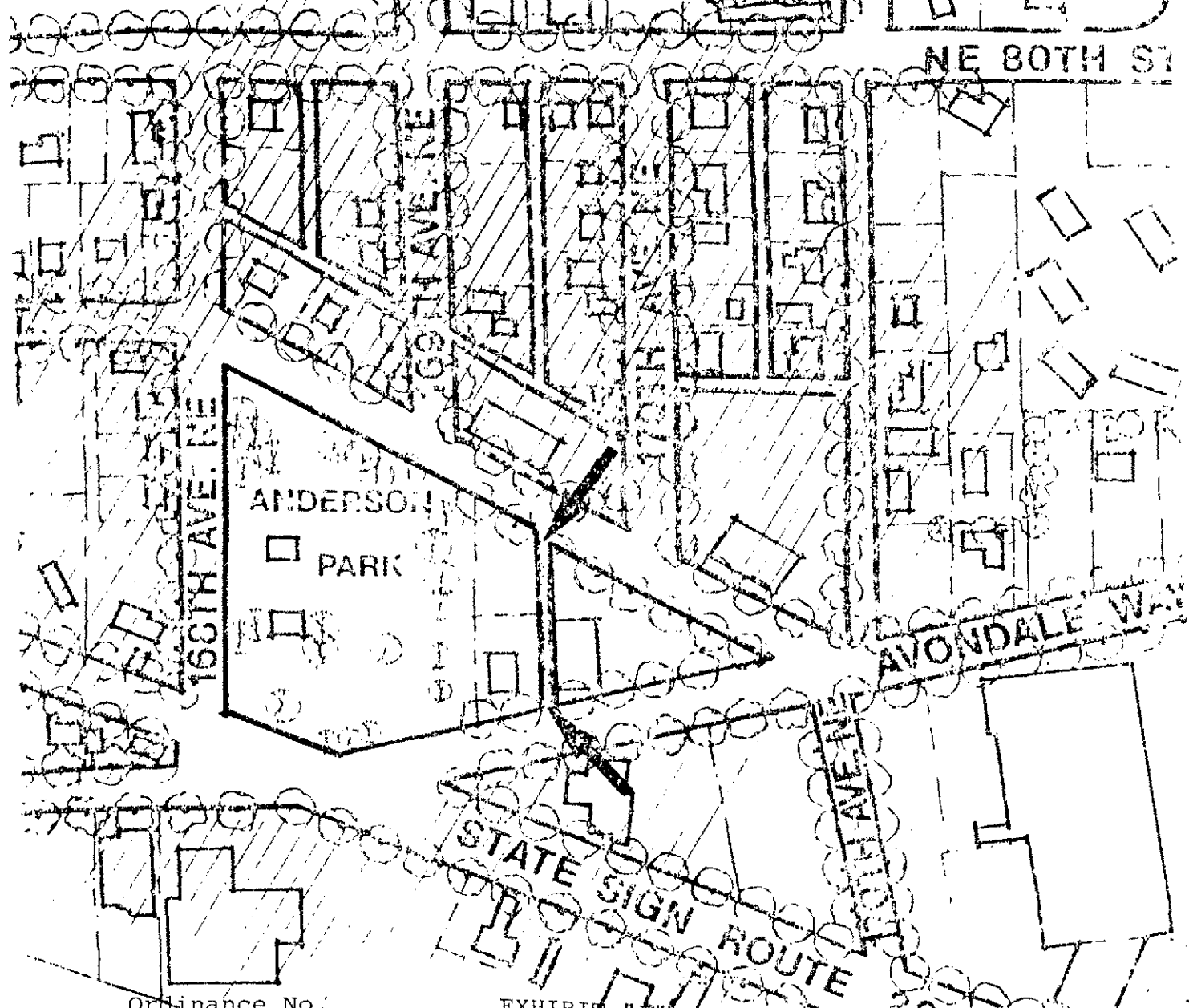
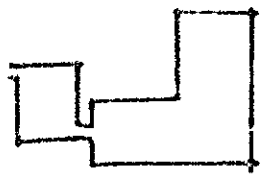
