ORDINANCE NO. 894

AN ORDINANCE, relating to police department dogs; prohibiting the interference and abuse of such dogs; and prescribing penalties for violations.


Section 1. Interference and abuse of police dogs prohibited. It shall be unlawful for any person to wilfully or maliciously interfere, obstruct, torture, beat, kick, strike, mutilate, injure, disable, shoot, kill or in any way to abuse or harass any dog used by any police officer in discharging or attempting to discharge any legal duty or power of his office.

Section 2. Police dogs excepted from animal control provisions. Any dog while being used by any police officer in the discharge of law enforcement activities shall be exempted from the provisions of Chapter 7.04 of the Redmond Municipal Code relating to animal control.

Section 3. Penalties for violations. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be punished as provided by Section 1.01.110 of the Redmond Municipal Code.
