ORDINANCE NO. 913

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF REDMOND RELATING LOCATION OF MEETINGS OF THE CITY COUNCIL AND AMENDING SECTION 2.08.020 OF THE REDMOND MUNI-CIPAL CODE

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2.08.020 of the Redmond Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

> "2.08.020 Place. All meetings of the City Council, whether regular or special, shall be held at the Council Chambers of the City Hall of the City of Redmond except as hereinafter provided. The City Council may, at its discretion, adjourn a meeting to any other appropriate place either within or outside the corporate limits of the City and notice shall be posted at the City Hall setting forth the location to which the meeting has been adjourned. Nothing contained herein shall be construed to prohibit or otherwise limit the City Council from setting the location of either a special or regular meeting at a location outside the corporate limits of the City of Redmond upon the giving of notice as may be required by the State Open Public Meetings Act as codified in RCW Chapter 42.30 and by also posting notice of the location at the City Hall."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect five (5) days following its passage and publication as provided by law.
