ORDINANCE NO. 933

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASH-INGTON, RELATING TO SALARIES AND WAGES, AMENDING SECTION 1(E) OF ORDINANCE NO. 910, PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL ON APRIL 15, 1980, TO AMEND THE SALARY GRAD OF THE DEPARTMENT SECRETARY (POLICE) FROM GRADE 77 TO GRADE 76 AND THE EXECUTIVE SECRETARY FROM GRADE 78 TO GRADE 77.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 910 was passed by the City Council on April 15, 1980, and contained scrivener's errors in Section 1(E) which incorrectly listed the salary grade for the department secretary (police) as 77 and the executive secretary as grade 78, and

WHEREAS, the correct salary grade for the department secretary (police) is grade 76 and for the executive secretary is grade 77, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1(E) of Ordinance No. 910, passed by the City Council on April 15, 1980, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'E. Appendix IV, Page 10, City of Redmond Index of Position Titles by Salary Grade, Salary Plan E, shall be amended to provide the following non-exempt positions: Salary Grade 76 - Department Secretary (Police) and Grade 77 - Executive Secretary.

NOTE: The above positions are included ('non-exempt') under minimum wage and overtime pay provisions of the Washington State Wage Act."

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after passage and publication as provided by law. The amendment set forth in Section 1 shall be effective as of January 1, 1980.
