

Ordinance No 94

An Ordinance Declaring an Emergency and Appropriating not to exceed \$6,000.00 from the Water Revenue Fund for the Construction of a Dam, Such Appropriation to apply against the 1946 Budget item for Water Works Department

Whereas, the Water system of the Town of Redmond has been fed by springs and certain of those springs have gone dry during the summer of 1945, and

Whereas, there has been included in the Budget for 1946 the sum of \$12,450 00 for betterment of the Water system, and

Whereas, it is now evident that such springs will not yield sufficient water to supply the Town during 1946 and that in order to have an adequate supply it will be necessary to build an additional impounding dam to accumulate water during the winter season and that work on such dam proceed at once, and

Whereas, it could not reasonably have been anticipated at the time the 1945 budget was adopted that such springs would go dry and that it would be necessary to build the said impounding dam, and

Whereas, it appears that the cost of such dam will be in the neighborhood of \$6,000.00 and

Whereas, the Town of Redmond has in its Water Revenue Fund sufficient money to pay for the construction of said dam,

Now, Therefore, be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Redmond as follows:

Section 1 That an emergency exists making it necessary to construct an additional impounding dam at the source of supply of water for the water system of the Town of Redmond, that the said emergency could not have been anticipated at the time the 1945 budget was adopted, and that the probable cost of the construction of said dam is \$6,000 00

Section 2 That there is hereby appropriated for said purpose a sum not to exceed \$6,000.00 from the Water Revenue Fund of the Town of Redmond, which sum shall, upon the passage and approval of this ordinance, be used for the construction of the said dam, and that any portion of said sum spent during the year of 1945 shall be applied against the budget for 1946 of \$12,450.00 for betterment of the Water system.

Passed by the Town Council in regular session, this 17th day of October 1945
