

ORDINANCE NO. 947

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE REIMBURSEMENT OF CERTAIN EXPENSES FOR PERSONS REQUESTED TO INCUR EXPENDITURES ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; ADDING A NEW SECTION 3.64.015 TO THE REDMOND MUNICIPAL CODE AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond, from time to time, seeks job applicants from without the State of Washington, and

WHEREAS, it has been the City's experience that many qualified applicants are unable to afford the costs associated with traveling to enable the City to personally interview such applicants, and

WHEREAS, there is a need to provide reimbursement of certain expenses incurred by persons traveling to the City at the instance and request of the City as a direct result of the benefit to the City by reason of the incurrence of such expenses, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A new Section 3.64.015 entitled "Reimbursement of Expenses Incurred at Request of City Authorized" is hereby added to the Redmond Municipal Code to read as follows:

3.64.015 REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES INCURRED AT REQUEST OF CITY AUTHORIZED.

Persons who incur expenses at the request of the City for transportation and related expenses shall be entitled to reimbursement for all or a portion of such expenditures to the extent and as provided by the City Council in the same manner as set forth in Section 3.64.010 of this Code.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be applicable to all such authorized expenses as shall be incurred on or after November 10, 1980.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after its passage and publication as provided by law.


