Introduction of Ordinances

ORDINANCE NO. 957

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASH-INGTON, AMENDING SECTION 2.04.170 OF THE REDMOND MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO INTRO-DUCTION OF ORDINANCES.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2.04.170 of the Redmond Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

MOTIONS, RESOLUTIONS, ORDINANCES IN WRITING -2.04.170 WHEN - INTRODUCTION

The presiding officer and any member of the Council may require a motion to be reduced to writing prior to a vote upon the same. All resolutions and ordinances shall be in writing before being introduced at the meeting for adoption and shall be assigned a number by the City Clerk when introduced. It shall be sufficient for the Mayor or the Mayor's designee to orally read the title of the resolution or ordinance at the meeting to present the same to the Council for its consideration prior to its voting on the question of adoption of said ordinance or resolution; provided, that a majority of the Council may require the entire resolution or ordinance or any part thereof to be read aloud at the meeting prior to voting on the question of adoption.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after its passage and publication as provided by law.
