

ORDINANCE NO. 961

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, SUPPLEMENTING AND REVISING THE SCHEDULE OF SPEED LIMITS SET FORTH IN SECTION 10.24.060 OF THE REDMOND MUNICIPAL CODE.

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WHEREAS, annexations have extended the City limits to encompass roadways not previously governed by the maximum speed limits set forth in Section 10.24.060 of the Redmond Municipal Code, and

WHEREAS, based upon the results of engineering and traffic investigation, the City Traffic Engineer has recommended that the speed limits governing travel on certain roadways within the City be revised, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the speed limit provisions instituted by this ordinance will result in the establishment of safe and reasonable speed limits, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That portion of the schedule of speed limits set forth in Section 10.24.060 of the Redmond Municipal Code which establishes a forty mile per hour maximum speed limit for all traffic on both sides of the Redmond-Kirkland Road (SR 908) from West Lake Sammamish Parkway (SR 901) to the previous western boundary of the City at 136th Avenue N.E. is hereby revised by including both sides of the Redmond-Kirkland Road (SR 908) to the present western City limits at 132nd Avenue N.E.

Section 2. That portion of the schedule of speed limits set forth in Section 10.24.060 of the Redmond Municipal Code which establishes a maximum speed limit of thirty

miles per hour for all traffic on both sides of Redmond Way (SR 202) from the junction of SR 908 to the former eastern boundary of the City at Bear Creek is hereby revised to provide that the thirty mile per hour speed limit regulation shall terminate at Avondale Road (SR 920).

Section 3. The schedule of speed limits set forth in Section 10.24.060 of the Redmond Municipal Code is hereby supplemented by adding the establishment of a forty mile per hour speed limit for all traffic on both sides of the Redmond-Fall City Road (SR 202) from the Avondale Road (SR 920) to the eastern City limits (185th Avenue N.E.).

Section 4. That portion of the schedule of speed limits set forth in Section 10.24.060 of the Redmond Municipal Code which establishes a maximum speed limit of forty miles per hour for all traffic on both sides of West Lake Sammamish Parkway (SR 901) from N.E. 51st Street to the Bellevue-Redmond Road (temporary SR 520) is hereby revised to establish a maximum speed limit of thirty-five miles per hour for all traffic on both sides of said portion of West Lake Sammamish Parkway.

Section 5. That portion of the schedule of speed limits set forth in Section 10.24.060 of the Redmond Municipal Code which establishes a maximum speed limit of forty miles per hour for all traffic on both sides of West Lake Sammamish Parkway N.E. (SR 901) from Leary Way to the Redmond-Kirkland Road/Junction SSH 2-D (SR 901) Spur is hereby revised to establish a maximum speed limit of thirty-five miles per hour for all traffic on both sides of West Lake Sammamish Parkway N.E. (SR 901) from the City limits at a point .11 mile south of Leary Way to the Redmond-Kirkland Road (SR 908).

Section 6. The Traffic Engineer is hereby directed

to post signs in accordance with Section 10.24.050 of the Redmond Municipal Code, giving notice of the speed limits established by this ordinance after the effective date hereof and upon concurrence of the Washington State Secretary of Transportation where required by law.

Section 7. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 8. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after its passage and publication by posting as provided by law.


