

ORDINANCE NO. 965

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, REVISING THE SCHEDULE OF SPEED LIMITS SET FORTH IN SECTION 10.24.060 OF THE REDMOND MUNICIPAL CODE.

WHEREAS, street and utility construction scheduled to commence as of February 2, 1981, on and along Willows Road from its intersection with Redmond Way to N.E. 124th Street is now or will shortly be in progress, necessitating a reduction in the current 45 mile per hour speed limit on said roadway in the interest of traffic safety, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That portion of the schedule of speed limits set forth in Section 10.24.060 of the Redmond Municipal Code which establishes the maximum speed limit for all traffic on both sides of Willows Road from its intersection with Redmond Way to the north City limits at N.E. 124th Street, is hereby revised to reduce the maximum speed limit on said roadway for all traffic in both directions to 25 miles per hour.

Section 2. The traffic engineer is hereby directed to post signs in accordance with Section 10.24.050 of the Redmond Municipal Code, giving notice of the speed limit established by this ordinance after the effective date hereof.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after its passage and publication by posting as provided by law.
