ORDINANCE NO. 968

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING SECTION 5.12.020 OF THE REDMOND MUNICIPAL CODE TO LOWER THE AGE FOR APPLICANTS FOR A PRIVATE DETECTIVE OR PRIVATE GUARD LICENSE TO EIGHTEEN (18); AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, frequently private detectives and/or private guards licensed under Chapter 5.12 of the Redmond Municipal Code are not required to carry a firearm and, thus, do not need to be twenty-one (21) years of age to perform the functions of such position, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 5.12.020 of the Redmond Municipal Code establishing the requirements for a private detective and/or private guard is hereby amended to read as follows:

Engaging in the detective/guard business without license unlawful. It is unlawful for any person, unless duly licensed pursuant to this chapter to engage in or advertise or hold himself out as being engaged in the private detective business and/or private guard business; provided, that no license required herein shall be granted to any person (1) who within ten (10) years of the date of application for such license has been convicted of any felony, or (2) who is under twenty-one (21) years of age if required to bear a firearm, or (3) who is under eighteen (18) years of age if not required to bear a firearm.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after passage and publication by posting as provided by law.


