

An Ordinance amending Ordinance No.79, Regulating and Restricting the use of property for business and commercial purposes.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Redmond as follows:

Sec.1 That section 3 of ordinance No 79 shall be amended to read as follows: That the following described property shall be included in the Business district.

Beginning on the South line of Jackson Street in the Town of Redmond, 1171.63 feet East of the Northwest corner of Section 12, Township 25 North, Range 5 E.W.M. Thence South parallel to the Section line to a point on the North line of Primary State Highway No 2, Thence Easterly along the North line of Primary State Highway No 2 to the East line of the N.W.1/4 of the N.W.1/4 of Section 12, thence North to the South line of Jackson Street, thence Westerly to beginning, except the East 30 feet for Street.

Together with the following described property:

That portion of the N.W.1/4 of the N.W.1/4 of Section 12, Township 25 North, Range 5 East W.M. described as follows:

Beginning on the South line of Faulds Road, 305.63 feet East and 378 Feet more or less South of the Northwest corner of said Section; thence East 72 Feet; thence South parallel to the West line of said Section to the North line of New Sunset Highway; thence Northwesterly along said Highway line to a point South of beginning; thence North to point of beginning.

And in addition thereto the following described property;

Commencing at the corner common to Sections 1, 2, 11 and 12, Township 25 North, Range 5 East, W.M. thence East 427.63 Feet; thence South 378 Feet more or less to the South line of the W.A. Faulds Road; thence West 50 Feet along the South line of the W.A. Faulds Road; thence South 150 Feet; thence East 50 Feet; thence North 150 Feet to the W.A. Faulds Road, except portion for State Road No.2.
