ORDINANCE NO. 972

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, VACATING CERTAIN PROPERTY IN THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DEDICATED FOR STREET PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, pursuant Resolution No. 576, the City Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, held a public hearing to consider the proposed vacation of certain property in the City of Redmond dedicated for street purposes and commonly known as a portion of old Cotterill Road (No 818), and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the findings of the City's responsible official, the City Council finds that there will be no significant adverse environmental impacts, and

WHEREAS, at the conclusion of said public hearing the Council found that the property previously dedicated for street purposes should be vacated, and

WHEREAS, the Council does hereby determine to vacate the property as hereinafter set forth, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following parcel of property, previously dedicated for street purposes is hereby vacated. Said parcel is located in the City of Redmond, King County, Washington, and legally described as follows:

The North 200 feet, as measured along the West line of that portion of Government Lot 9, Section 13, Township 25 North, Range 5 East, W.M., in King County, Washington, lying Westerly of Cotterill Road No. 818;

EXCEPT any portion of said premises lying within the South 988 feet of said Government lot;
AND EXCEPT that portion thereof lying within County Road No. 966 "172nd Avenue Northeast", situate in the City of Redmond, County of King, State of Washington.

Section 2. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this ordinance with the King County Recorder.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after passage and publication by posting as provided by law.


