ORDINANCE NO. 984

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 972 VACATING A PORTION OF OLD COTTERILL ROAD TO CORRECT THE LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF THE PROPERTY VACATED.

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 972, passed on April 21, 1981, the City Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, vacated a portion of Old Cotterill Road, and

WHEREAS, the legal description of the property vacated was incorrectly stated in Ordinance No. 972, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 972, passed by the City Council on April 21, 1981, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. The following parcel of property, previously dedicated for street purposes is hereby vacated. Said parcel is located in the City of Redmond, King County, Washington, and legally described as follows:


All that portion of Government Lot 9 in Section 13, Township 25 North, Range 5 East, W.M., in the City of Redmond, King County, Washington, lying southwesterly of Lake Sammamish Parkway N.E. (60 feet wide) and lying easterly of County Road No. 966 (172nd Avenue N.E.).

EXCEPT the south 988 feet of said Government Lot 9.

Section 2. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this ordinance with the King County Recorder.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after passage and publication by posting as provided by law.
