ORDINANCE NO. 986

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, SUPPLEMENTING AND REVISING THE SCHEDULE OF SPEED LIMITS SET FORTH IN SECTION 10.24.060 OF THE REDMOND MUNICIPAL CODE.

WHEREAS, based upon the results of engineering and traffic investigation, the City Traffic Engineer has recommended that the speed limits governing travel on certain roadways within the City be revised, and


WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the speed limit provisions instituted by this ordinance will result in the establishment of safe and reasonable speed limits, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That portion of the Schedule of Speed Limits set forth in Section 10.24.060 of the Redmond Municipal Code which presently establishes a 40 mile per hour speed limit for northbound traffic on 148th Avenue N.E. from the south City limits at N.E. 20th Street to N.E. 24th Street is revised by reducing said speed limit to 35 miles per hour.


Section 2. The Traffic Engineer is hereby directed to post signs in accordance with Section 10.24.050 of the Redmond Municipal Code, giving notice of the speed limit established by this ordinance after the effective date hereof, and upon concurrence of the Washington State Secretary of Transportation where required by law.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after its passage and publication by posting as provided by law.
