

ORDINANCE NO. 989

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING THE REDMOND MUNICIPAL CODE AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT GUIDE (DGA-81-9) BY REPEALING SECTION 20E.10.060 ENTITLED "CREATION AND ESTABLISHMENT OF FIRE ZONES" TO CONFORM WITH THE 1979 UNIFORM BUILDING CODE.

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, adopted the 1979 Uniform Building Code by Ordinance No. 912, passed by the City Council on April 15, 1980, and

WHEREAS, the 1979 Uniform Building Code eliminated all fire zones due to the adoption of new building construction standards,

WHEREAS, the Policy Advisory Commission held a public hearing on May 13, 1981 for the purpose of considering proposed development guide amendment DGA-81-9, the proposed repeal of Section 20.E.10.060 of the Redmond Municipal Code and Community Development Guide and following said hearing formulated its recommendation to the City Council to approve said amendment, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, having considered the recommendation of the Policy Advisory Commission at its regular meeting of July 7, 1981 and having determined that the recommendation should be followed, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 20E.10.060 of the Redmond Municipal Code and Community Development Guide is hereby repealed and

henceforth the designation "(reserved)" shall appear in the Community Development Guide following said section number.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after passage and publication by posting as provided by law.


