CITY OF REDMOND RESOLUTION NO. 1443

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY WASHINGTON, DECLARING THE FEE OF REDMOND, INTEREST IN CERTAIN REAL PROPERTIES OWNED BY THE CITY'S WATER UTILITY AND COMMONLY KNOWN WATERSHED, PERRIGO SPRINGS SURPLUS TO THE NEEDS OF THE UTILITY, TRANSFERRING OWNERSHIP OF THE SAME TO THE GENERAL FUND TO BE USED FOR STREET PURPOSES, RIGHT RESERVING ΤO THEUTILITY THE UTILIZE THE SAME FOR UTILITY PURPOSES

WHEREAS, certain properties commonly known as the Perrigo Springs Watershed in the City of Redmond, are assets of the City of Redmond's water utility; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the properties are encumbered by access easements to provide access to adjacent properties; and

WHEREAS, a portion of one asset property was previously declared surplus to the needs of the water utility and improved as a public street; and

WHEREAS, the water utility has made improvements of a street, pedestrian sidewalk and drainage system on the asset properties not yet declared surplus; and

WHEREAS, the owner of an immediately adjacent property to the improved, but not yet surplused properties, has approached the City about additional rights to access the improvements in order to service and support further development of its property; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department has advised the City Council that the fee interest in portions of the utility properties is surplus to the utility's needs, and the utility need only maintain the right to place waterlines and a transmission main, and have access thereto, in the properties as the means of serving the area; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department has recommended the fee interest in portions of the properties be declared surplus to the utility's needs and that the same be transferred to the general fund for use of the property for public right-of-way purposes, in exchange for the sum of Fifty Thousand and no/100 Dollars which is the fair market value of the improved property interest encumbered by the existing access easements and the continued utilities use; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 35.94.040, the City Council held a public hearing in order to consider declaring the fee interest to be surplused and to specify the terms and conditions under which the transfer could take place, and after considering all public testimony received at the hearing, the City Council has determined to pass this resolution.

NOW, THERFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Property Declared Surplus. The fee interest area in those properties commonly known as the Perrigo Springs Watershed and legally described on Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference as if set forth in full, is hereby declared to be surplus to the needs of the City's water utility and the only interest required by the utility for providing continued water utility service is declared to be an easement or use right.

Section 2. Authorization for Transfer. The Mayor and Finance Director are hereby authorized to take such steps as may be necessary to transfer the properties described on Exhibit A from being assets of the utility to being assets of the general fund for purposes of public street right-of-way, subject to the utility retaining the right to utilize the properties for utility purposes. The transfer shall take place in exchange for the payment of Fifty Thousand and no/100 Dollars from the general fund to the appropriate utility fund. Such transfer shall be made upon payment to the city of the sum of Fifty Thousand and no/100 Dollars by a third-party.
